#### **Starting Time**

Please check the enclosed pairing sheet for your starting time on Monday, July 1. Play will begin from the 1st tee. Tee times and groupings will be made available to you after 12pm on Saturday, June 29. Remember that local qualifying is 18 holes, that you must walk in all phases of the Amateur and that you are responsible for providing your own caddie/cart driver. Caddies might be available at Kiawah Resort. Contact the Ocean Course caddie master. Players must walk but you may carry your own bag during the qualifying round. Caddies can rent a cart for the qualifying round at this site and transport a players clubs. However, caddies may have to share carts during the qualifying round. Only two carts per group will be allowed.

#### **USGA Policies**

The USGA prohibits the use of cellular phones during qualifying and championship rounds. Also, the USGA does not allow spectator carts during qualifying rounds or the championship proper for any reason. If you have spectators please make sure they understand they have to walk at all times during the qualifying round. Please plan accordingly. Electronic Measuring Devices are not allowed.

# Practice Round/Cart Fees/Food and Beverage

You are entitled to <u>one</u> practice round on Sunday, June 30. You may call the Cougar golf shop anytime to schedule a practice round tee time. Make sure to identify yourself as a U.S. Women's Amateur Championship qualifying participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling.

There is a <u>mandatory</u> \$40.00 cart/range fee for the practice round which *includes* your range fee for July 1. Cart fee for caddies/cart drivers on July 1 is \$25.00. <u>Make sure to check-in with the golf shop when you arrive and pay your appropriate fees!</u> Cougar Point accepts **all forms of payment for Golf shop or food and beverage purchases.** If additional guests wish to play the rate is \$171 per person.

## **Qualifying Schedule**

**Sunday, June 30** Official practice round. Must call golf shop in advance to schedule a tee time.

Monday, July 1 Qualifying round: 18 holes of stroke play. Playoffs for qualifying spots and alternates immediately following play.

## **Pace of Play Policy**

A player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds is subject to a warning and will be so advised. The player will be notified that exceeding 40 seconds on one more occasion will result in a penalty of one stroke. A third violation will result in a two-stroke penalty, followed by disqualification. A player's time to play begins when she has had a reasonable opportunity to reach her ball and when it is the player's turn to play and can do so without interference or distraction. Penalties are applied individually, but more than one competitor in a group may be penalized.
