Tournament Information

Format: Championship and Junior division: 36-holes of individual stroke play. Players will be flighted after the first

round. Sub junior division: 18-holes of individual stroke play (9 holes each day).

Practice round: A practice round will be available at the Longleaf G&FC from July 5 through July 10 at a rate (walking) of \$20.

Contestants must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Please identify yourself as

Carolinas Junior Girls 15 & Under participant when calling.

Starting times: Starting times will be available on Tuesday, July 5 after 12pm on the carolinasgolf.org web site or by calling

the CGA office.

Yardages: Approx. 5,600 yards (white tees) for championship; 5,000 yards (orange tees) for junior division. Sub-juniors

will play approx. 2,460 yards (blue tees)

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the overall champion and the top three places in each division.

Caddies: Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddie. Caddie must be 18 years of age or younger, no

exceptions. Caddies must walk at all times. Players may use push carts.

Measuring devices: Measuring devices may be used during the championship.

Spectator carts: Spectator carts will be available to rent for \$20 per person. All carts are restricted to the cart path.

Player Registration: Players registration will be at the Longleaf G&FC on Sunday, July 10th from 11:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Social Functions: Sunday, July 10 – 7:00 pm Cook out with college players

assisting with the search for a ball.

Withdraws: If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office at

may be suspended from CGA events for 1 year.
