55th Carolinas Senior Four-Ball Championship

Conducted by the Carolinas Golf Association

Quixote Club, Sumter, SC April 24-26, 2023

ELIGIBILITY AND FIELD SIZE

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has reached his 55th birthday by April 24, 2023, and maintains a residence in North Carolina or South Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has an active USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club that does not exceed 9.9. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct as defined in the CGA Code of Conduct Policy for current or future championships. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in the "Rules of Golf".

For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the <u>CGA Tournament</u> <u>Manual</u>.

Championship field size = 72 teams.

ENTRY FEES (All Course Fees Paid by the CGA to the Host Club)

Championship Entry Fee: \$415 (includes cart/range fees for all tournament rounds and lunch for one round)

ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

Exempt Early Entry Window*: Open February 20th at 8:00pm | Close March 5th at 11:59pm

Non-Exempt/Open Entry Window: Open March 6th at 8:00pm | Close April 13th at 11:59pm

All players, including those exempt, must register online at www.carolinasgolf.org. Mail-in applications are no longer accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

Entries are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.

*Exempt players must register between 8:00pm on February 20th and 11:59pm on March 5th to ensure acceptance. Exempt players that sign up after 8:00pm on March 6th and non-exempt players gain entry into the tournament on a first come first serve basis.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance and tournament information is sent to players when their status has been determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Senior Four-Ball Championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Any withdrawal the day prior to or the day of the championship will not receive a refund. All other withdrawals are subject to a \$30 admin fee.

Withdraw Day Prior To or on Championship Date: No refund for any reason.

Alternates/Wait List: Full refund if player does not gain entry into championship.

COURSE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

Practice Rounds: Cart rental is mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors pay host club directly for practice round fees.

Championship Rounds: Championship round cart & range fees are included in the entry fee. Competitors have the option to walk or use a golf cart during championship rounds

Caddies: Refer to Player Information for specific Qualifier or Championship site.

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: During the play of a hole, either the player or his caddie may ride in a golf cart <u>but not both at the same time</u>. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Refer to Player Information for specific qualifier or championship site for spectator information.

RUIFS

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

The championship format is 54 holes of four-ball stroke play. Gross scores only. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low 30 scores and ties. A tie for the overall championship is decided by an on-course playoff.

PRIZES

Merchandise prizes are awarded to the top 20 teams and ties at the championship. Champions receive trophies and merchandise from host club.

EXEMPTIONS

Players in the following categories are exempt into the championship if otherwise eligible. A complete list of exempt players is available on the championship website.

- 1. Champions of the Carolinas Senior Four-Ball Championship since 2013.
- 2. Teams that finished 20th or better at the 2022 Carolinas Senior Four-Ball Championship.
- 3. Players who competed in a 2022 USGA Championship.
- 4. One exemption for championship host club.
- 5. Special exemption bestowed by the CGA.

Exempt team members must compete on the same team or with another exempt player in order to register during the exempt entry window. (You may not sign up early with a non-exempt team member).

*Exempt players must register between 8:00pm on February 20th and 11:59pm on March 5th to ensure acceptance. Exempt players that sign up after 8:00pm on March 6th and non-exempt players gain entry into the tournament on a first come first serve basis.

CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

Sunday, April 23

Tee times available for practice.

Monday, April 24

First round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play.

Tuesday, April 25

Second round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play.

Field cut to low 30 scores and ties for final round.

Wednesday, April 26

Final round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play.
